Academic Requirements

- Any **LSU** Law student in good standing who has completed at least one full semester of full-time study of the law is eligible to participate in the certificate program. 1L students in their first semester may enroll but will not be considered "active" until after their first semester transcripts are audited.
- Students must complete at least 16 total credit hours within the Certificate program curriculum: 12 hours from mandatory courses and 4+ credit hours from elective courses.
- Students must write a research paper in the area of energy law.
- Students must participate in at least 14 hours of approved Applied Learning Experiences (ALE) related to energy law and policy.
