I hope this message finds you well and bearing up under the stresses of not only this difficult summer, but also of your bar exam studies, wherever you may be. If you are studying for the Louisiana Bar Exam, this message is for you.

Attached to this email you will find a press release from the Louisiana Supreme Court and the Louisiana Supreme Court Committee on Bar Examination. It announces an option, available to persons already registered for either the July 27 or October 10 Louisiana Bar Exam, to take the examination remotely using a remote proctoring protocol, if they wish to do so due to health or other concerns.

Per the release, existing applicants will be contacted soon with the question as whether they wish to change their selection from an in-person location to the remote option. As of right now, additional information is not on the website to detail the relevant technology or other information, but current applicants are directed to monitor the site regularly for more information. <https://www.lascba.org/>

I do not have additional details at this time, other than to say remote proctoring does involve a webcam, identity verification, and monitoring of your activities via the webcam. Further I cannot say. I will continue to share with you information as I receive it.

THE LOUISIANA SUPREME COURT AND THE LOUISIANA SUPREME COURT COMMITTEE ON BAR ADMISSIONS ANNOUNCE ONLINE BAR EXAMINATION OPTION

The Louisiana Supreme Court (the “Court”) and the Louisiana Supreme Court Committee on Bar Admissions (the “LASCBA”) jointly announce the addition of an option to take the July, 2020 and October, 2020 bar examination online. All other details regarding the administration of the July, 2020 and October, 2020 examinations remain unchanged.

In addition to the in-person cities announced on May 8, 2020, the bar examination can now also be taken online from any location within the United States, in an effort to provide an additional option for applicants who, due to health or other concerns, prefer to sit for the examination in a remote location.

The application deadline for both the July, 2020 and October, 2020 examinations closed on May 30 and will not be reopened to new applicants at this time. Within the next few days, staff of the LASCBA will be contacting existing applicants to inquire as to whether they wish to change their selection from an in-person location to the remote option.

Because the administration of the remote examination requires the hiring and training of more proctors than the in-person administration, there may be a need to limit the number of remote takers. The previously-announced priority schedule will apply to the selection of the remote option: (1) first-time test-takers, prioritized by the date application and fees were received by LASCBA, and (2) repeat takers, prioritized by the date application and fees were received by LASCBA.

Applicants are expected to check the [LASCBA's website](#) regularly for additional announcements regarding this matter.
